
## W2K system types




Provides a wide range of new benefits, features and functionality

- ? Value Lower TCO
- ? Reliability -?

## Requires significant time, money, and personal investment

- ? Training issues for admins and end users
- ? Operating system, client access license, and add on services costs
- ? Significant change in code base, many new features, greater chance of errors
- ? Slow adoption, smaller knowledge base
- ? Requires infrastructure changes, DNS







## Gives you

- ? Site awareness (closest DC is used)
- ? Active Directory Service Interfaces (ADSI)
- ? DFS fault tolerance client
- ? Active Directory Windows Address Book
- ? NTLM version 2 authentication

## Does not give you

- ? Kerberos support
- ? Group Policy nor IntelliMirror support
- ? IPsec nor L2TP support
- ? SPN nor mutual authentication
